

Colquitt Regional Medical Center is a 99-bed hospital that recently underwent a \$30 million renovation. The facility is over 290,000 square ft., with over 1,100 employees and 70 physicians on the medical staff.

Now featuring all private rooms, Colquitt Regional consistently scores in the 90th percentile nationwide for patient satisfaction and was recently named a Top Rural Hospital by the LeapFrog Group. They were the only hospital in Georgia to receive this designation.

The well-known Vereen Rehabilitation Center is also located on the Colquitt Regional campus providing physical, occupational, and speech therapies in addition to a wound care clinic.
